Since its founding in 1968, The Housing Corporation has been a leader in the efforts to expand housing opportunities. Its founding chairman, Jackson C. Hinds, was Mayor Louie Welch's chairman of the Housing Advisory Committee, which prepared an application for the Model Cities program for the City and drafted and supported the enactment of a minimum standards housing code.
